Weed Board

The Commissioners stated they did not have a problem doing that; the issue would need to be brought before the County Council.

County Highway

Right-of-Way Certification Letter

Joe Copeland distributed a letter to obtain signatures for right-of-way certification on County Roads 600 West and 1050 East. This letter is needed to apply for stimulus money.

Speed Limits

Commissioner Stevens made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Armstrong to have the County Attorney draw up a new Ordinance pertaining to Speed Limits on CR 400 West and CR 400 South. Actual vote 3-0

Intersection – CR 400 East & CR 200 North

Joe Copeland informed the Commissioners he had received a telephone call from Gary Achor, Hancock County Sheriff's Department, stating there have been a lot of accidents at the Intersection for CR 400 East & CR 200 North.

Railroad Property

Susan Bodkin, County Surveyor appeared before the Commissioners to discuss the Railroad Property and the need for a legal description. She will obtain quotes from vendors.
