

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

Comes now the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, the Board of Works and Public Safety of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, the Commissioners of Hancock County, Indiana, and the County Council of Hancock County, Indiana, and enter into an Interlocal Agreement pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-7, said agreement to be as follows:

1. Purpose. The purpose of this agreement is to define the terms and conditions under which the City of Greenfield, Indiana, by and through the Greenfield Fire Department, or its legal successor in interest, shall provide emergency ambulance and emergency medical services to the residents of Hancock County, Indiana, outside of Center Township, seven (7) days a week, twenty-four (24) hours each day for the year 2009.

2. Payment. Hancock County shall pay to the City of Greenfield, Indiana, or its legal successor in interest the sum of \$250,000.00 in two payments of \$125,000.00 each on June 1 and December 1, 2009, upon claims filed.

3. Termination. This agreement supersedes and terminates, effective January 1, 2009, any previous agreement regarding ambulance service between the parties whose signatures appear below. This agreement terminates December 31, 2009, and when it terminates it does not reinstate the previous agreements.

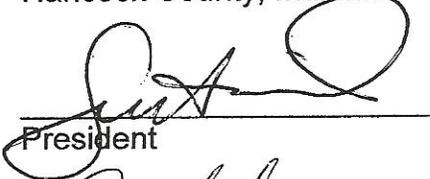

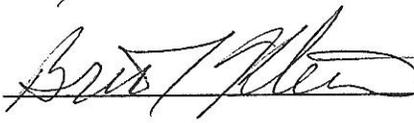
