

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SMOKE FREE WORKPLACE ORDINANCE

Be It Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Hancock County, Indiana, That

Section I

Section 91.59 of Chapter 91 of Title IX of the Hancock County Code is amended as follows:

§ 91.59 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

(A) A person who smokes in an area where smoking is prohibited by the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction, punishable by a fine not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

(B) A person who owns, manages, operates, or otherwise controls a public place or place of work/employment and who fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance, except §91.52(C), shall be guilty of an infraction, punishable by:

- (1) A fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a first violation.
- (2) A fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for a second violation within one (1) year.
- (3) A fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each additional violation within one (1) year.

(C) Each day on which a violation of this Ordinance occurs shall be **FILED** considered a separate and distinct violation.
