The County Council of Hancock County, Indiana met in the County Commissioner's Court in the Courthouse Annex located at 111 American Legion Place Greenfield, Indiana 46140 on the 29th day of September 2021 at the hour of 8:30 AM in accordance with the rules of the Council.

Highway

- Gary Pool (County Engineer) requested additional appropriation in Local Road and Street, Line Item 23104 for \$900,000 to repave and micro surface 700 W.

Public Hearing: 2022 Solid Waste Management District Budget

- Councilmember Gray opened the public hearing at 8:33 AM for 2022 Solid Waste Management District Budget. Councilmember Gray asked for public comments then closed the public hearing at 8:33 AM.
- Councilmembers agreed to adopt on October 13, 2021

Budget Transfers

- Councilmember Fisk made a motion to transfer \$2,400 from Supplies to Personal Services for the Weed Specialist. Councilmember Shelby seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**
- Councilmember Lowder made a motion to transfer \$40,000 from Capital to Personal Services for Highway Fund 1176. Councilmember Fisk seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**
- Councilmember Fisk made a motion to transfer \$34,000 from Personal Services to Supplies for Highway Fund 1173. Councilmember Butrum seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**
- Councilmembers approved to advertise for additional appropriation of \$2,500 for Problem Solving Grant (Drug Court).
- Councilmember Shelby made a motion to pay FSG invoices from Economic Development. Councilmember Fisk seconded the motion. **Motion carried 5-0.**
