AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

Resolution No. 3000 - 5-1

Resolution authorizing the filing of an application for a grant under Section 5311/5339 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to states through the Federal

Transit Administration (FTA) to support capital, operating and feasibility study assistance projects for nonurbanized public transportation systems under Section 5311 of the FTA Act of 1964, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Office of Transit, Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) has been designated by the Governor to make Section 5311/5339 grants for public transportation projects.

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY Hancock County Commissioners:

- That John Jessup, President on behalf of Hancock County Commissioners is authorized to make the
 necessary assurances and certifications and be empowered to enter into an agreement with INDOT for
 the provision of rural public transportation services.
- That Hancock County Senior Services, Inc. is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of Hancock County Commissioners with the INDOT to aid in the financing of transit assistance projects pursuant to Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act, as amended.
- 3. That Hancock County Senior Services, Inc. is authorized to furnish such additional information as INDOT may require in connection with the application.
- 4. That Hancock County Senior Services, Inc. is authorized to execute grant contract agreements on behalf of Hancock County Commissioners.
