Motion passed 3-0.

Bridge Inspection Contract-Commissioner Stevens made a motion to sign a contract with INDOT for County Bridge Inspection. EDS # A249-10-321405. Commissioner Armstrong seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0.

Earl Smith's Well-Mr. Earl Smith of 575 East appeared before the Commissioners and said he may lose his certification to sell grade A milk because of his well. He stated he cannot pass the minimum requirements for the water and the inspector said it could be because his water is low for his well. The inspector will be back in a couple of days to re-inspect and he will know something then.
