

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF SUBSTANCES
CONTAINING SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS OR THEIR USE

Be It Ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Hancock County, Indiana, That

Section I

Chapter 130 of Title XII of the Hancock County Code is amended by the addition of a new section 130.08 as follows:

§ 130.08: SALE OF SUBSTANCES CONTAINING SYNTHETIC CANNABINOIDS OR THEIR USE PROHIBITED.

(A) Products containing synthetic cannabinoids ("Products"), such as K2/Spice, or similar products which contain one or more of the following chemical compounds:

(1) (6aR,10aR)-9-(hydroxymethyl)-6,6-dimethyl-3-(2methyloctan-2-yl)6a,7,10,10a-tetrahydrobenzo[c]chromen-1-ol, also known as HU-210;

(2) 1-Pentyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, also known as JWH-018;

(3) 1-Butyl-3-(1-naphthoyl)indole, also known as JWH-073; or

(4) Any other equivalent compound or derivative shall not be sold, marketed, offered for sale, burned, incinerated or ignited.

(B) Any person, firm, or corporation who violates any provision of this section shall be fined an amount set out in Hancock County Code Section 10.99.
