Come now the undersigned, as presiding Judges of the Hancock Circuit Court and the Hancock Superior Court No. 1, and enter the following Memorandum Order:

- 1. On March 23, 2020, the Governor of the State of Indiana, Governor Eric J. Holcombe, issued Executive Order 20-08, wherein Indiana residents are generally ordered to stay-at-home unless traveling for the purpose of health and safety, essential work activities, taking care of others, or obtaining essential supplies.
- 2. Executive Order 20-08 shall take effect at 11:59 p.m. on March 24, 2020 and shall remain in full force and effect until 11:59 p.m. on April 6, 2020, unless the Executive Order is rescinded, modified, or extended by the Governor of the State of Indiana.
- 3. Executive Order 20-08 does not vacate, modify, or suspend any parenting time or custodial Order issued by the Hancock Circuit Court or the Hancock Superior Court No. 1.
- 4. All parenting time or custodial Orders issued by the Hancock Circuit Court or the Hancock Superior Court No. 1 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Parenting time exchanges shall continue to occur as Ordered by the Hancock Circuit Court or the Hancock Superior Court No. 1.
- 6. Upon proper Petition and an opportunity to be heard, any party found to have violated a parenting time or custodial Order may be found in contempt of court and sanctioned accordingly.
